Board of Selectmen met before the Special Town Meeting to discuss the Selectmen's Articles.

Ms. Villano stated the Board needed to discuss Article 3 and Article 5 and a motion needed to be made to postpone them. Article 3 and Article 5 were bylaw changes, removing them in their entirety, and the Finance Committee had made some inquiries and there wasn't enough information together to answer definitively whether to keep them or not.

Mr. Goncalves made a motion that we postpone Articles 3 and 5 so that we can look into it a little further and see what makes sense, what doesn't, seconded by Ms. Fernandes. Vote 5-0 all in favor.


Ms. Villano inquired if anyone had any questions or wanted to discuss any other articles. She informed the Board about a change to Article 1. A Baystate bill was added for \$614.51 at the last minute.

Mr. Silva asked if he was required to read the metes and bounds for Maria's Way. Ms. Villano indicated they have never read it before and all that has been said was as printed in the warrant, but Mr. Silva could confirm with the moderator. Ms. Villano also indicated that this is the second time we're accepting this particular street because the developer wanted to deed it over to the Town and missed the 120-day deadline, so it's been a year back and forth with the attorneys.

Mr. DeBarge wondered if Article 6, the recycling contract, was going to go without any questions. Ms. Villano indicated the fact that it's a 10-year contract is what requires a vote at Town Meeting and that it is kind of intergovernmental so really the Board of Selectmen should be entering into it.

Ms. Villano informed the Board that Sean McBride confirmed his attendance in case there were any questions about the golf deficit. The Board discussed the fact that its weather dependent.

Mr. Goncalves made a motion to adjourn at 7:10 p.m., seconded by Ms. Fernandes. Vote 5-0 all in favor.
