Moved by Mr. Goncalves, seconded by Mr. Rosenblum to file. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

109a & b. John R. Mahar, Director of Governmental Affairs, Charter Communications – letter of notification of channel lineup changes.

Moved by Mr. Rosenblum, seconded by Mr. Silva to file. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

110. Joshua D. Schimmel, Executive Director, Springfield Water and Sewer Commission – providing the Board copies of the Springfield Water and Sewer Commission's annual Water Quality Report for Calendar Year 2019.

Moved by Mr. Goncalves, seconded by Mr. Rosenblum to file. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

Unfinished Business:

Board discussed the COVID-19 crisis and updates. Mr. DeBarge stated that as of today the Town of Ludlow has approximately 91 positive cases. Received an excellent response for the request for donations in order to make masks and hand out to residents as needed.

Moved by Mr. Silva, seconded by Mr. Rosenblum for the Board to open the Special Town Meeting to insert articles for easements for the new Senior Center for water/sewer and gas. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

Moved by Mr. Goncalves, seconded by Mr. Silva for the Board to close the Special Town Meeting Warrant. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

New Business:

Moved by Mr. Silva, seconded by Mr. Goncalves to approve the second amendment to the contract between the Town and Wright-Pierce for the Riverside and ratify the Chairman's signature of execution. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

Board discussed the ideas of letting restaurants open outside only when they are first allowed and the ability to alter the premises to the liquor licenses in order to serve alcohol outside.

Moved by Mr. Silva, seconded by Mr. Rosenblum to approve authorization of the chairman to sign on the behalf of the entire Board when a majority of the Board's signature is needed during the time of the pandemic and to last through the pandemic and the Governor's lifting of the emergency. Vote 4-0. All in favor.

Chairman approved and signed all bills, warrants and abatements. A record of all warrants is in the Selectmen's office for perusal until provided to the Town Accountant's office.

Closing Comments:


