

Minutes of the Ludlow Cultural Council

January 11, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Michelle Goncalves at 6:10 pm.

The meeting was conducted virtually/Zoom.

Present at meeting were: Susan Amaral, Nira Flatley, Jeff Gavioli, Michelle Goncalves, Robert Radowski, Janet Settembro and Matt Tibbits.

1) Discussion of LCC-organized events: do we want to organize an event of our own? Discussion followed. Example of a LCC sponsored event was the Art on River Walk. Pictures and art were displayed on and along the River Walk walkway in Ludlow. We would withhold about 10% of grant funds for this event. Several members agreed this was a well received event and might like to see it organized again. Another idea was a Town holiday lighting ceremony held at Gazebo or Town Hall involving Town school bands, school choirs etc. Several members agreed to help out with these events.

Motion was made by Nira Flatley to allocate 15% of funds for a LCC sponsored event. Matt Tibbits stated perhaps we should move to grant application awards first and then consider what funds were left for LCC sponsored events. Nira withdrew her motion at this time to allocate funds.

2) Discussion of Council Survey: Michelle Goncalves presented survey and responses. We had 63 responses with most from Ludlow. The big "take away" from this survey was that many people in Ludlow do not know that the Ludlow Cultural Council exists and who/what it is. Most responders did attend Celebrate Ludlow, School concerts and concerts at Gazebo. Several members agreed that perhaps banners/signage are needed to show that events are sponsored by the Ludlow Cultural Council. Also, advanced notice of upcoming events included week of and day of events. Maybe one Council member to attend at least one event and inform attendees of what event(s) are coming up next. Take a look at our Facebook page. Share it with others.

Other comments from surveys regarded perhaps a need for porta-potties.

More discussion followed as to how we can increase attendance at future events. All members were in agreement that we need to get our name out in the public. Signs, banners and

pamphlets at events is good idea. Per surveys received, a change in time for gazebo events ED was suggested. A change from 6-8 pm to 5-7 pm.

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The survey remains open until January 31, 2021

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Motion made by Nira Flatley and seconded by Jeff Gavioli to change time of Gazeto OF LUDLOW events from 6:00-8:00 p.m. to 5:00-7:00 p.m. Motion was passed with all members in favor

3) Discussion of FY21 grant applications and vote on distribution of funds Michelle Goncalves informed Council that FY20 grant applications were extended to 12/31/21, if applicants sent in a request by 12/15/20. Per spreadsheet presented by Michelle there were 10 applicants extended.
