
Minutes of the Ludlow Cultural Council

Further discussion included: possibility of beer trucks, need for better/more food trucks, ice cream truck, community organizations/nonprofits associated with Ludlow to sponsor Summer Concerts.

Mention was made of possible amphitheater at the former location of Vets Park Elementary School being talked about.
