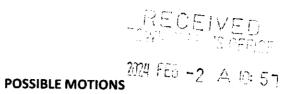
Chapter 40B of Massachusetts General Law states that as a regional planning agency, the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission (PVPC) "...shall, annually in the month of February, estimate the amount of money required to pay the costs and expenses of the district for the following fiscal year; shall fix and determine the proportion of such costs and expenses to be paid by the constituent cities and towns thereof during such fiscal year; and, shall certify the amount so determined for each city and town to the assessors thereof who shall include the sum in the tax levy of such fiscal year... Such apportioned cost shall be on a per capita basis in direct proportion to the population of the city or town and the planning district as they appear in the most recent national census."

The Commission's proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2025 recommends that the assessments paid by the member municipalities be increased by 2.5% and be assessed on the basis of a \$.18713 per capita assessment rate to determine each community's share of the expenses of the planning district for the upcoming fiscal year.

If approved by a vote of the Commission, this increased assessment rate would be levied on the Commission's 43 member cities and towns during the FY 2025 budget cycle (i.e. July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025). The official 2020 U.S. Census population totals will continue to be the basis of each member community's local assessment obligation for the year. The attached table identifies the proportion of the costs and expenses to be paid by the constituent municipalities in FY 2025, along with each city or town's official population total as determined by the 2020 U.S. Census.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission certify the FY 2025 local assessments as depicted on the attached schedule. The PVPC will then notify the assessors of constituent cities and towns as each member community's share of the costs and expenses of the district for the Fiscal Year 2025 period as required by state law.
